NO vote needed	<p>Notes: Parent Question: We have high student to teacher ratios for all grades. Why did we increase the allowable students per class? Who did that benefit? Are we able to bring in teacher aids to help alleviate current teachers, increase student performance and increase overall moral? Our teachers work an extra hour a day and also have more students than the district average. Such a shame for our wonderful IB school.</p> <p>School opened with additional hour in the schedule for multiple reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">a. shared property therefor accommodating drop off and pick upb. IB Expectations on curriculum needs the additional hour to accommodate all programs (art, spanish, musicc. as a charter school we are held to a different standard than the same district expectations than that of a public school within our district.

High student ratio: With regard to higher class sizes we are aligned with the current LUSD class size enrollment numbers and ratios. The class sizes increased years ago in order to continue to financially support the charter as we receive money based on pupil enrollment. This also allowed for us to fund special programs such as art music spanish as well as save money for our future school site. In addition the class size increases were voted on by teaching staff at that time. With regard to aids; generally there is no parent educators in general education within LUSD.
