This year, Alison created a team to take over with a team to run each event. An email will be sent out to that grade to see who wants to help. Jog-a-thon is a 4th grade event. Oct. 6th. It's a big event for our school. Our future looks bright is the theme for the event. A team will help. 99 pledges was sent out to start fundraising.
