Item Summary	<p>1) STARSTRUCK: recap and plan for next year. – going into it last minute we didn't know what to expect, but we were very happy with the event and so were the kids. Check in was smooth. We are hopeful to get a spot next year but we are at the bottom of the scheduling list. This year was less planned because we were given the spot so last minute but next year will have better communication and easier to see how the schedules will work. Lots of good came out of it, kids loved it, bonded with others, brave students to dance in front of big audience, and brings the community together. A great opportunity for performing arts that we don't have for our kids.</p> <p>Reason behind \$10 donations was because we didn't have field trips this year. The donations didn't cover the costs of starstruck itself, so that is why we had to charge for entry fee. Total cost of starstruck was \$3,700. It was not a planned fundraiser because it was last minute, so it wasn't included in our budget for this year.</p> <p>Liz says the teachers felt it was a bit much and last minute – but they would like to be a part of the communication in the future. The teachers didn't dance because they would have had to dance at their lunch time, and it was a busy time and too much going on and so last minute.
