	<p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Courtney R proposed budget 23/24 (attached) -Tina: PTC went through line items this summer to create goals based on previous years. “Total” column should be used as a “maximum” amount used on each line item. -To note: Charter Schools receive a different amount of funding from the district- so our PTC needs to run a higher budget in order to cover items that would’ve otherwise be covered by the district. We cover items such as 4 day/week Spanish, assemblies, etc in order to give our kids an “IB” education. -Some funds are being pulled into a new school plan- so Spanish was taken down to 2 days/week for PYP, but PTC was able to raise funds to get Spanish to 4 days/week. -Tina- we keep reserves for approximately 2 years, in case large funds are not received (for example, if Auction couldn’t happen on year, etc) -Staff appreciation budget increased -Some one-time budget items for facilities are on the budget this year, but will not be included next year (updating playground etc) -Pledge Drive: 9k. We are hoping this is raised, but we won’t know for sure. Pledge drive reimburses the PTC for giving each teacher \$500 per classroom to spend however they want. They get \$500 whether their students give money or not. -If teachers want more than the \$500 allotted, they can write a grant request from PTC. <p>VOTE: 9 yeas. 0 nays.</p>
