<p>Ayes 9 ___ Nos 0 ___ Abstained 0 ___</p>	<p>Treasurer Update</p> <p>Review and vote on 2024/25 PTC Budget: complete.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Sombrero Time contract is complete, and we do not need to fund \$40,000 for Spanish</li> <li>-Budget is available by request, but as an overview, we have eliminated spanish budget, decreased facilities (many projects have been completed), added approx \$500 to each event, teacher and staff appreciation increased, auction budget increased, and more.</li> <li>-Patty Fletcher to prompt MYP teachers to push webstore payments for exploratories</li> <li>-FYI: PTC fronts all field trip expenses, and we expect to be repaid by webstore payments</li> </ul>
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Update from Director or Teacher Representative - Shauna Newton

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-LBEF Grant: \$10,000 per year grant. Was used for Spanish in the past but this year Spanish is covered by the District. Should be used for "Arts", so we will use this grant for Shakesphere this year. (Shakesphere is a tradition for 7th graders at LBCS every spring)</li> <li>-Behavior Modification at LBCS -multi-tiered system for positive reinforcement. PTC funds used for supplying treats for incentives, as well as a "check-in/check-out" system for specific students and their larger incentives.</li> <li>-Need for walkie talkies: approximately \$300/walkie talkie. Shauna is speaking with Kevin about getting new walkie-talkies so PTC is not responsible for this charge.</li> <li>-New staff fridge- originally it was thought this would be covered by PTC, but Kevin reported this will be paid for by District.</li> <li>-On track to purchase 3 chromebook carts: 2 purchased by PTC funds, and one purchased by the school. Goal would be a 1:1 device ratio for all classes. (\$16,000/cart) we are almost completely 1:1, except for Spanish.</li> </ul>
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To note, 4th grade's chromebooks will need to be replaced in the next few years.

LBCS Events Update - Alison Davis and Kasey Branting
