Final Measure E Update - Did not pass, 48% voted Yes and we needed 55%.

New Charter- Update from Al Frangione:  
 "I have had several meetings with our State funding folks and have a schedule to get our funding application in likely around late February (possibly sooner) for a preliminary approval for our Charter relocation. Once approved, we will proceed with plans and group meetings to develop drawings for DSA approval and final funding approval. Funding will likely be 50% from the State. I am working on plans for the other 50%.
