Update from Director or Teacher Representative - Shauna Newton/LBCS Teacher

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Working on getting Kinder Docent for every day help. Will post as a vacancy for "Learning Docent". Shawna will follow up 2. Spanish IXL: Kevin said this can come out of LBCS budget from district, PTC does not need to pay for this. This will be for Spanish IXL, MYP only. 3. Speakers: Obvious need for improved speaker system for the school. Discussed whether we should use the PTC speaker for every day use (MRU, events, etc) or we should pick up another system. Decided to use the current system for every day use (MRU) but PTC system for events. Shawna is working on a location for storage and charging- perhaps music room, so it is on campus whenever staff needs it. Shawna to discuss PTC purchasing Bluetooth enabled speakers for events such as Veteran's Day assembly, IB Parade, Dances, etc- will speak with Brian Renick about which system would be most beneficial. Shawna mentioned there might be a tech budget from the district next year, which could potentially pay for the speakers. 4. Buckhorn Grill offered to cater staff holiday party! Thank you Sergio, from Buckhorn, Rocklin. We will place a shoutout in the school newsletter. Courtney R to look into using Buckhorn for Auction catering. 5. Huge thank you from Shawna to PTC- this school wouldn't be what it is without all the help and volunteerism she sees around our campus! 6. Christine Clark: we need masks for MYP Exploratory Fencing. Not enough funds in Exploratory budget, so teachers need to push parents to pay Exploratory fees. Patty Fletcher will push out to MYP teachers. (43 parents paid for fall semester, 4 have paid for spring). Christine will fill out PTC grant request form and PTC will vote. Cost will be approximately \$600.
